

SPECIAL TRIBUTE FOR STEPHEN GAY

As we come together this weekend to celebrate our love of our dogs. this great sport of agility and the excitement of competing in the BC/VI/Yukon Regional Championships, I would like to take a moment to honour a good friend who has left a huge impact on me and this event.

My friend Stephen Gay passed away at the beginning of May. Many of you who have been around agility in the lower mainland for the last 20 years will likely remember him well. Some of you will not. But he has left a legacy for you.

Stephen was a founding member of Pacific Agility Clan (PAC) with Rob Chipman and Joanie Leigh Elliot. Joanie Leigh is still hosting PAC trials today, carrying on what Stephen started. He and his border collie Kane were always a fun team to watch, Stephen running with his hands in his pockets and Kane with his little crooked nose! We trialed together a lot, always spicing things up with a good challenge like doing Snooker from a "gamble box" or Gamblers with no words!

The other impact Stephen had was in helping me to develop the AAC Regionals and Nationals program we have today. When the AAC board tasked me with developing a program back in 2000, they said "pick your team and get it done!". Stephen was my first choice, because of his ability to debate both sides of any topic (I never knew what side he actually favoured in these discussions that's how good he was!), his computer programming skills, his data analysis skills and his computer programming skills, his data dilaysis skills and his commitment to developing a program that included all types of agility handler/dog teams. So myself, Stephen and another long time AAC judge and BC/VI competitor Bernadette Van Klaveren, developed our Regionals and Nationals program and it has stood the test of time. It is the same program we developed 24 years ago now. It took us less than a year to get the first Begional and National event organized and than a year to get the first Regional and National event organized and in 2001 we had our first Nationals at Spruce Meadows. Much credit goes to Stephen for the work he did to make sure the scoring was fair for everyone. (Stephen, I still don't know what a Bell Curve is... but I trusted you that it was important!)

So this weekend I hope you all have an amazing time with your friends, your family, 2 and 4 legged. I have been in this sport almost 30 years now, I have competed at the regionals with 10 different dogs. I have seen amazing dogs in BC come and go over the last 24 years. We never have them long enough. Every time I attend regionals I am excited to see my friends that I don't get to see as often as I would like, and I think about the ones, human and dog, that I won't see again, sadly.

I ask that you remember what the people like my friend Stephen have contributed, what the Regionals and Nationals host clubs, and the many, many volunteers do for our sport and our Association. These events don't pop out of thin air. There is a massive amount of work that goes into developing them and running them year after year. Take a moment to look around at the beautiful venue, thank your instructors or mentors for their help getting you here, thank your amazing dogs for meeting you at the finish line and never judging us for our moments of imperfection out there! Breathe, smile and RUN!

Regionals for ... **SPONSORS & RAFFLE**

KNOW THE RULES!



General Rules (Possible Grounds for Dismissal from the Event!):

- BE KIND
- PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG
- NO DOG-DOG, HUMAN-DOG, OR HUMAN-HUMAN AGGRESSION WILL BE TOLERATED
- NO TREATS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE RINGS
- (except for warm-up runs) DOGS MUST ENTER ON LEASH AND EXIT ON LEASH (LEASH BUCKETS WILL BE PROVIDED)

REGIONALS SCORING: AAC Regionals Rules & Guidelines (CLICK LINK to go to AAC website for details) states that scoring is based on a combination of speed and accuracy across multiple runs. Competitors must complete:

- **Two Jumpers runs**
- Two Standard runs
- Two Gamblers runs

Each run is **timed**, and faults—such as knocking down a bar or missing a contact zone—result in penalties that either add to the dog's time or deduct from their score. Bonus points are given for clear rounds and successful gambles. The aggregate score from these runs determines the winners, with the highest-scoring dogs in each category being declared the regional champions.

Nationals Qualification

To qualify for the AAC National Championships, a dog must earn a minimum of 350 points across all six runs.

Junior Handlers and competitors using the Accessibility Option need 300 points to qualify.

*IMPORTANT: Copies of Scribe Sheets will be available in a bin outside of each Ring - Competitors should check for errors, and if needed, SPEAK to the JUDGE right away as only they can overturn what is written on the scribe sheets! Competitors will also receive **EMAIL RESULTS** throughout the day, if there are errors, report it to the **HEAD TRIAL** SCORER who will verify it with the physical Scribe Sheet (but NOT with the Judge as they likely will not remember your run at that point).



SITE SECURITY

Volunteer Security will monitor entry to the site at the indoor crating area and the Regular and Special/Vet rings for competitor wristbands. Please ensure you and your guests are wearing their wristbands at all times when on-site. Security will be on-site overnight around the competition rings and designated crating areas. However, we must stress that competitors' property left on site is at your own risk.

PARKING

Competitors and the General Public can park their vehicles in all designated parking areas on the site as long as it does not block fire lanes. Competitors and their dogs may also crate inside their vehicles during the event; however, this may be a fair distance from the competition rings. If competitors choose to crate in their cars, we ask that you take care of any personal belongings and ensure to monitor your dogs left in cars. Organizers may ask competitors to move their vehicles or not to leave their dogs in their vehicles if there are signs of distress or safety concerns.



WEATHER

Regionals runs will go forward unless there are extreme and dangerous weather conditions. Competitors should be prepared for possible rain, wind, and extreme heat. Some play pools and hoses will be available onsite, but competitors should bring drinking water, tarps, shade cloth, fans, or other appropriate extreme weather items.

FIRST AID

First Aid kits, an AED device and individuals trained in First Aide will be onsite, but no doctors will be present. Ambulance Services will be called for any human injuries during the event.



To qualify for the money round on Sunday, you need to finish in the top 2 of your class of either of Friday's courses, whether you qualified for AAC purposes or not. If you finish in the top 2 in both Friday's runs, you still only get one chance to run on Sunday, but you have reduced the number of competitors you will be running against by keeping another dog out of that spot. There are potentially 4 competition spots in each of the 19 jump/division heights. Each height and division will have their own cash jackpot based on the number of entries in the two Friday Steeplechase events. There will be no combining of heights or divisions. There is no fee to enter the run-off round (but it is only open to those who are invited to run based on Friday's results) Qualifiers list for the Sunday event will be posted Sunday morning in the results area along with the jackpot amounts for each run-off.

Leaps N' Bounds Agility will be donating the net proceeds from the Friday Steeplechase events to the cash jackpots!




